## Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. How comfortable is the treatment?

The Petit Lady treatment causes only very slight discomfort. No anaesthetic is needed and most women find this treatment to be quick and easy.

### 2. How long is the "downtime"?

Immediately after the treatment you can continue with your normal activities. We suggest refraining from sexual intercourse for 3 days. Menstrual period might be disrupted by this treatment. Some patient may notice some spotting for a few days after the treatment.

### 3. Is the treatment fast?

Yes. The treatment is done in our clinic in Cardiff and it can be done in about 20 minutes. Please do not schedule for this treatment for when you are due to have your menstrual period.

### 4. How many treatments will I need?

Most patients only need 3 treatments with two to four weeks' intervals in-between. Severe cases may need six or more treatments. Most patients experience results after the first treatment. Maintenance treatments may be had once every 6 to 24 months where necessary.

### 5. How much does it cost?

We currently charge £500 per treatment.

## What is the Petit Lady Treatment?

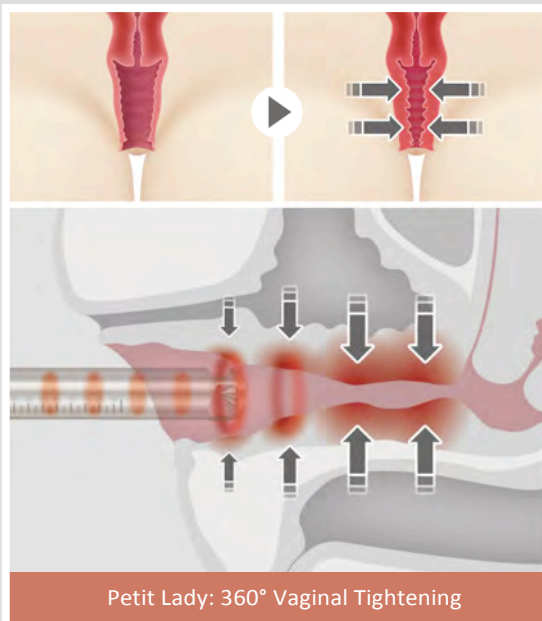
### 360° Vaginal Tightening with Action II

Petit Lady is a revolutionary non-surgical laser treatment that can treat both VRS and AV. This treatment is safe, gentle and causes very little discomfort. It only takes minutes to complete each Petit Lady treatment.

Some women suffer from excessive or pigmented vaginal labial skin which can be embarrassing and affecting their confidence. Petit Lady laser can be used to shrink these unwanted skin and reduce the pigmentation.

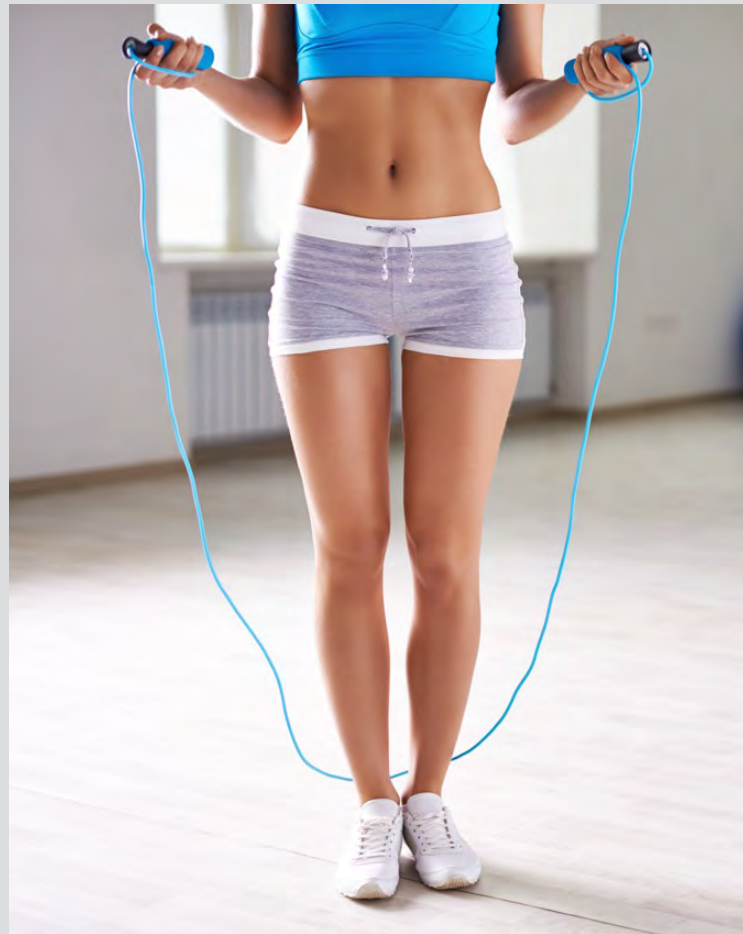

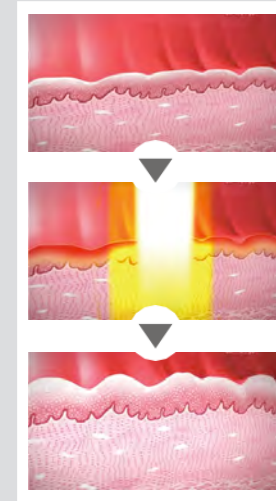

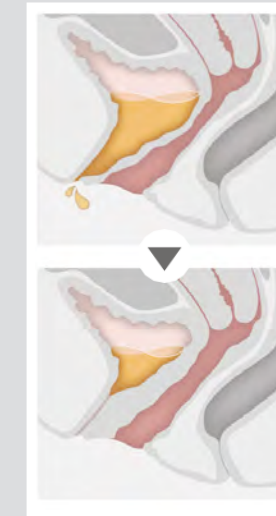
## Results You Can Feel

### Vaginal Tightening:



Petit Lady non-surgical laser treatment induces shrinkage of the vaginal wall. The laser energy gently targets the superficial layer of the vaginal wall to stimulate collagen remodelling and production.
